Offeren yn Gymraeg | **Mass in Welsh** Please note that next Sunday's 8.30am Mass will be our monthly Mass in Welsh. This would usually happen on the first Sunday of the month, but for various reasons needed to be moved for April – and unfortunately it will have to move in May as well: the replacement date will be confirmed closer the time.

Safeguarding The Parish Safeguarding Representative in Aberystwyth is Tess Truss, whose details are at the top of every newsletter. One of Tess's main roles is to ensure that all those who carry out parish visiting, or taking holy Communion to the sick, or any ministry that involves working with children or vulnerable adults, go through a DBS check. To complete a DBS check, the form will ask for various forms of ID and a history of addresses, among other things. Tess is ready to assist anyone who requires a check. Once the paperwork is sent off, these checks can take quite a long time to come back, and so ministries are sometimes delayed as a result. Unfortunately that's a situation that's out of our hands, and the diocese is doing its best to speed the system up.

Good Shepherd Sunday Next Sunday is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood, and also the annual collection for the Priest Training Fund which covers the costs of a man's initial formation during seminary, which over seven years is about £185,000. This is a wonderful investment in the future of the Church, though is a significant outlay. Many thanks for whatever you're able to give to this Fund. Formation Talks Many thanks to James January-McCann for part one of his two talks on the Catholic Faith in Wales, before and after the Reformation. James reminded us that in Welsh, Catholicism is sometimes referred to as 'Yr Hen Ffydd', meaning 'the old faith' – a phrase which in English might not be so immediately recognisable as Catholicism, and which perhaps is itself a clue to the deep Catholic roots of our country of Wales. His second talk will be in a couple of months' time. Before then, we look forward to talks number three and four in our Talk Series on the Our Father, being held during this Year of Prayer in preparation for the Jubilee of Hope in 2025.

Chapel of Our Lady at Welsh Martyrs There was a mistake in last week's newsletter – the next installment of works will take place this coming week, rather than last week, so please avoid the church this coming Tuesday!
