

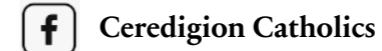

Good Shepherd Sunday This Sunday is the World Day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood. The training of new priests is an essential element of our Catholic faith, so that we see a continuation of the prayer of the Holy Mass, the absolution of sins in confession, and the sacramental presence of Christ the Shepherd in our midst. How wonderful it would be to have priestly vocations from our own parishes! Please offer something in your own prayer for this great intention today. Today is also the annual collection for our diocesan Priest Training Fund which covers the costs of a man's initial formation during seminary at a cost of about £185,000, whether or not he continues to priesthood. *Diolch yn fawr iawn*, many thanks indeed for whatever you're able to give to this Fund. Vocations Message Each year the Pope writes a message for this Good Shepherd Sunday – this year he talks about the virtue of hope, as we prepare for next year's Jubilee of Hope. You can find his message by using the QR code inside this paragraph. In the letter he says: *'To young people, and especially those who feel distant or uncertain about the Church, I want to say this: Let Jesus draw you to himself; bring him your important questions by reading the Gospels; let him challenge you by his presence... More than anyone else, Jesus respects our freedom. He does not impose, but proposes. Make room for him and you will find the way to happiness by following him. And, should he ask it of you, by giving yourself completely to him.'*

Police Commissioner Elections These take place on Thursday 2nd May, electing representative who will oversee how crime is tackled in the area covered by Dyfed-Powys Police Force. The aim of the Police Commissioners is to cut crime and to ensure the police force is effective. Please mark the date so that your voice is heard.

Children's Liturgy There won't be Children's Liturgy during 10am Mass on Sunday 21st April or Sunday 5th May.

Tuesday 30th April This day is the *Day of Prayer for Victims and Survivors of Abuse*. The focus for this year's Day is for communities who have been directly affected by allegations or convictions related to abuse, when an investigation into one individual affects the community of which they are a part. This focus, chosen by our Bishops' Conference, reminds us of how the damage of abuse is wide-reaching. We pray for those in our own parish communities who currently experience abusive environments, that they have somewhere safe to speak. Have you heard of **Safe Spaces**? This charity offers a space for anyone who has been abused either by someone in the Church or as a result of their relationship with the Church. Our Father Talk Series The next talk in the series of talks on the Our Father will be on **Wednesday 1st May** from 6.30-8.30pm in Neuadd Goffa (opposite St Anne's Church in Penparcau). Our speaker will be Professor Caroline Maybury, one of our own parishioners from Welsh Martyrs, who will speak to us on 'Writing the Kingdom' – she'll examine the words 'Thy Kingdom Come' from an iconographer's perspective, with a particular reference to beauty.
